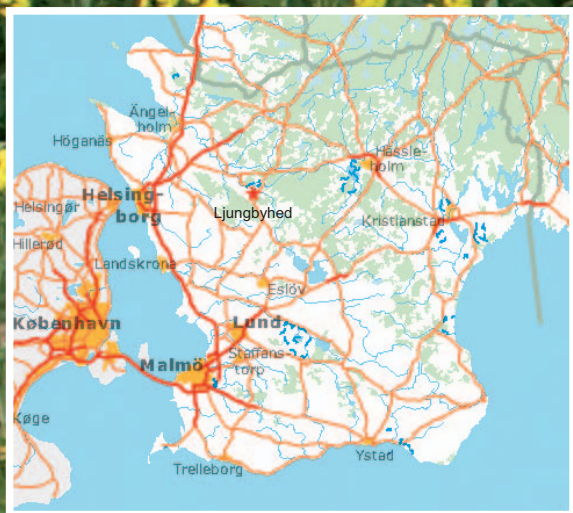

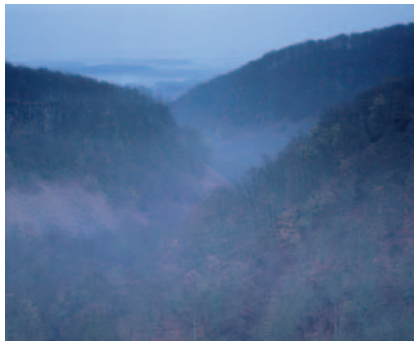
Saab across all borders

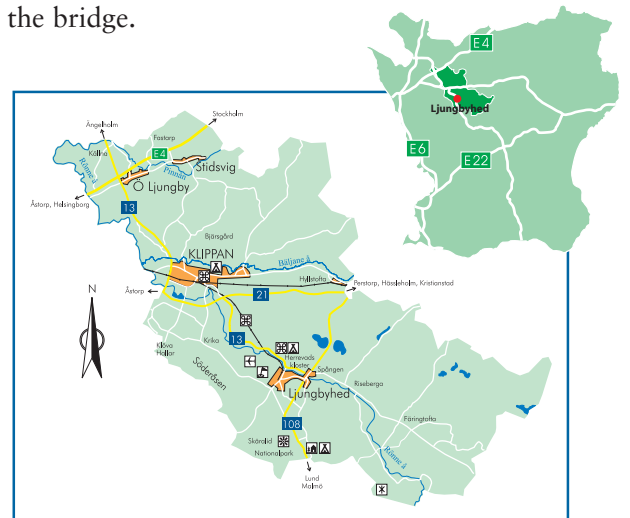


Close to the continent

The location of Ljungbyhed in Skåne is ideal wherever you are coming from. The distance from Hamburg is 380km, Brussels 930km, Stockholm 540km and the roads are excellent. We recommend all our guests from the continent to drive over the Öresundbron (the bridge between Copenhagen and Malmö). It is fast and we can offer you a 45% discount on the toll (ie 150 SEK one way ticket). The ferry from Helsingør to Helsingborg is an alternative to the bridge.



From the east. Hassleholm and Kristianstad, you follow the road 21. Even from the north it is easy to get here via E4 and E6. Exit E4 in Östra Ljungby or E6 in Ängelholm and follow road 13. After you have passed Klippan, follow road 21. Turn right at the roundabout and follow the two stroke smoke!





Airborne Saabs

Ljungbyhed is well known for its former air force base and training of fighter pilots. The airfield with all of its hangars is still there, but is now only used by private planes. You will practically be living on the airfield. This is a great advantage since all activity will take place on the airfield. It will also make it easier to meet new Saab friends in this border crossing event. Hotel, youth hostel, barrack rooms and camping are available on the airfield. There is a museum on the airfield describing the military history, dating back to 1680, of Ljungbyhed and the training of fighter pilots from 1926 to 1998.



Culture

In the small rivers of Ronnea and Baljana swim salmon, trout, pike and eel. The rivers are well known for their good fishing. Canoes can be rented and there are excellent picnic areas along the way. Within 30 minutes travel are 20 of the best golf courses in Sweden. Ljungbyhed has a brand new golf course.



For those interested in a different kind of culture there is a wide choice. You are standing on historic grounds. In the closeby Herravaeds monastery Tycho Brahe discovered the supernova Stella Nova in 1572. This discovery made him world famous. Gramanstorps medieval church is a historical monument. St. Petri church in Klippan is not as old but architectural students from all over the world come here since it is considered to be one of Swedens most architecturally perfect churches
